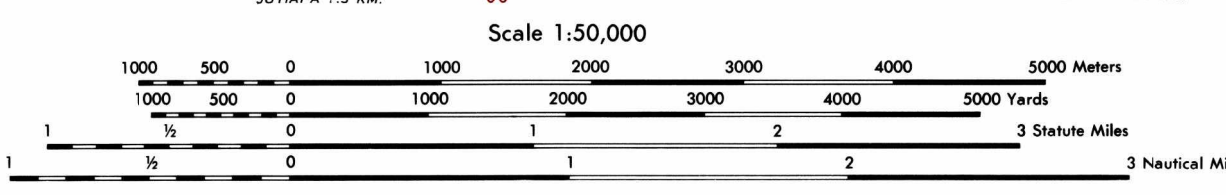




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MAP INFORMATION AS OF 1979 On this map a line is generally considered as being 8-12 feet (2.5-3.6 meters) in width
