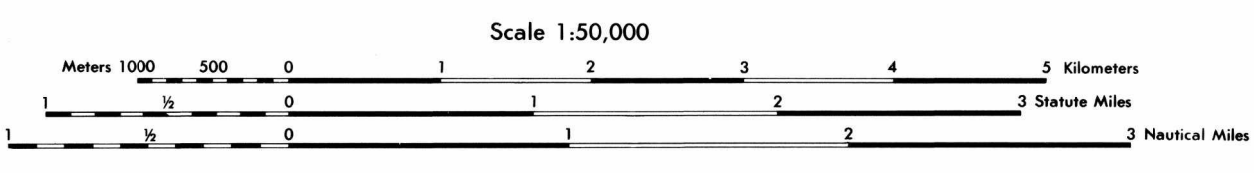

CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 METERS SUPPLEMENTARY CONTOURS 10 METERS

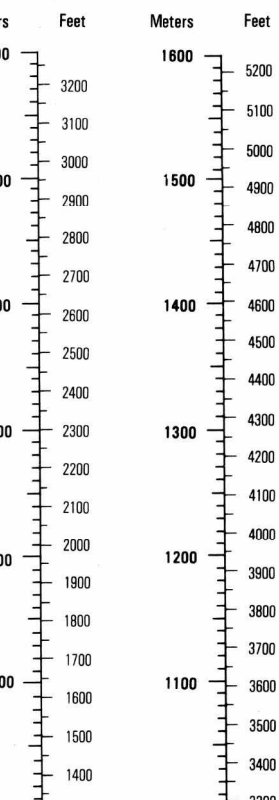

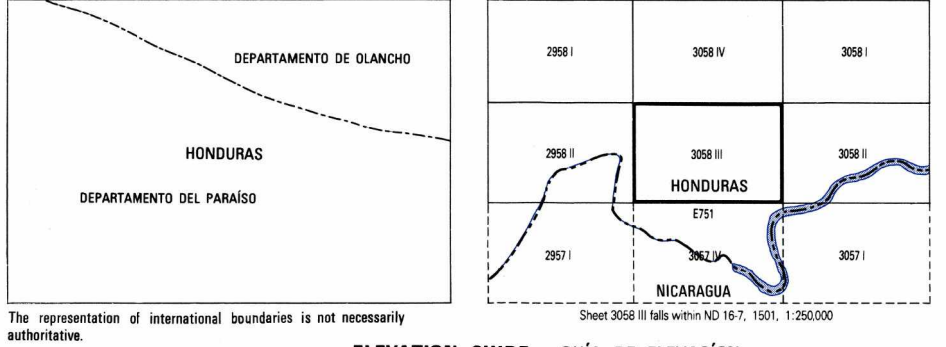

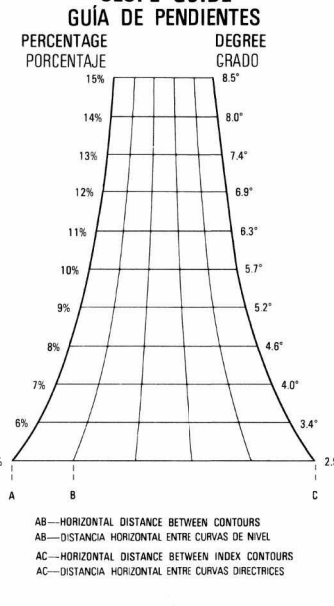
