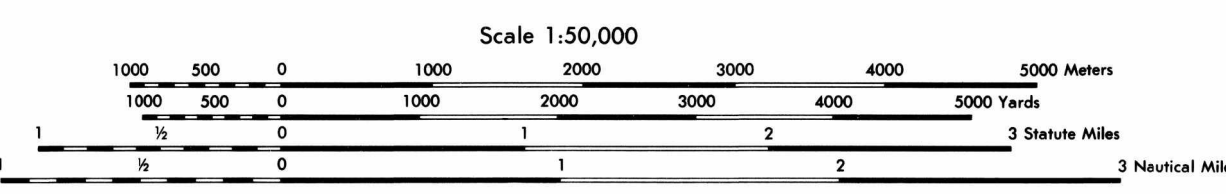


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LEGEND SIGNOS CONVENCIONALES

- MAP INFORMATION AS OF 1981
On this map a lane is generally considered as being 8-12 feet (2.5-3.6 meters) in width
IN ESTE MAPA UNA VÍA TIENE GENERALMENTE UNA ANCHURA DE 8 A 12 PIES (2.5-3.6 METROS)
ROADS: Dual highway, All weather, hard surface, two or more lanes wide, etc.
CAMINOS: Autopista, Para todo tiempo, carretera, etc.
RAILROADS: Normal gauge, single track, etc.
FERROCARRILES: Vía normal, vía única, etc.
Other symbols for bridges, boundaries, and various landmarks.
