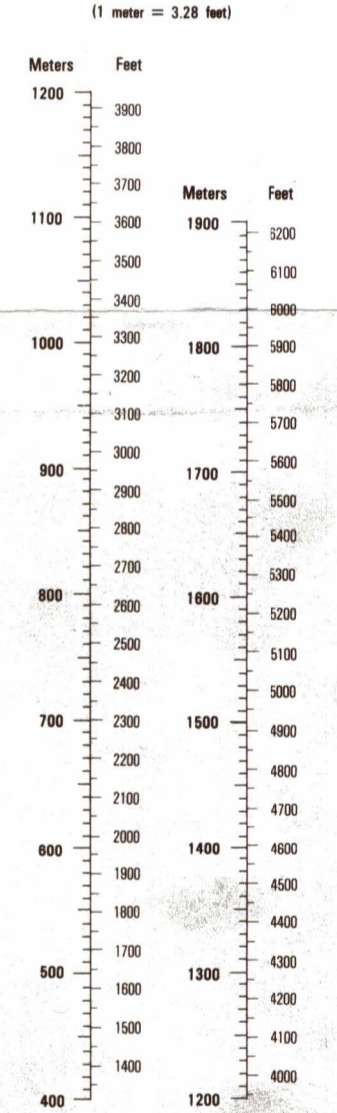
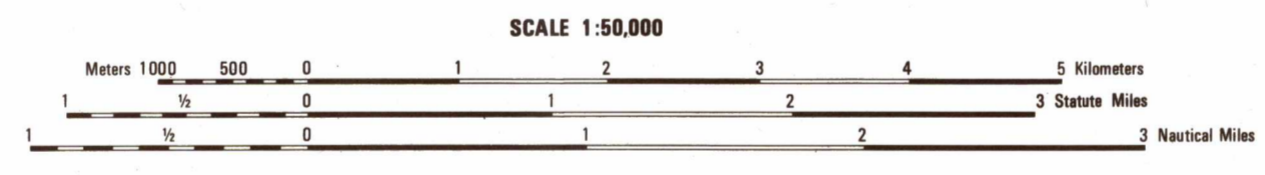


CONVERSION GRAPH GRÁFICO DE CONVERSIÓN

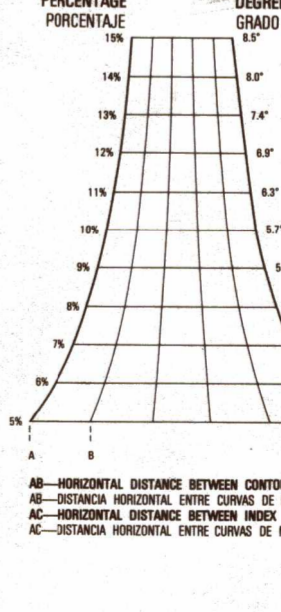
